DAY 3 – Eilat/Arava – Explore the 'wilderness', water activities and fun in Eilat.

DAY 4 – The High Desert – Discover the world's largest crater 'erosion cirque' and the desert treasures.

DAY 5 – A Nation Being Born – Tel Aviv; Rabin Square, Carmel Market, Old Jaffa and Nachlat Binyamin. Festive Shabbat dinner at the hotel.

DAY 6 - The Struggle for Independence — Explore the Ayalon Institute and the Museum of the Diaspora.

DAY 7 — Along the Mediterranean — Caesarea - the ancient Roman city, the amazing Baha'i Gardens and Mt. Carmel, Akko - a Unesco World heritage site and the 'blue grottos' at Rosh Hanikra.

DAY 8 – The Golan Heights – Jeep tour through the Golan Heights, **Oz 77**, site of a major tank battle, hike one of the beautiful **nature reserves** and wander through **Safed**, a city of spirituality and art.

DAY 9 – The Cradle of Christianity – The remains of **King Solomon's stables** at **Tel Megiddo**; **Nazareth** where Jesus spent his childhood; **Capernaum**, where Jesus began his Ministry; the beautiful mosaic floor in **Tabgha** and **Mt. of Beatitudes**.

DAY 10 – Along the Jordan Valley Rift – Tiberias and Lake Kinneret, Beit Shean - Israel's largest archaeological site; Beit Alfa synagogue with its unique mosaic floor; the gorgeous Gan Hashlosha (Sachne). Shehechyanu blessing atop of Mt. Scopus viewing the City of Gold. Enjoy The Night Spectacular Sound & Light show.

DAY 11 – Ancient Testimonies – City of David, the core of ancient Jerusalem; walk along the Southern Wall steps, Davidson Center and Robinson's Arch; roam in the Arab Bazaar; ; visit the holiest site in Judaism – the Kotel and explore the Western Wall Tunnels; view the restored Hurva Synagogue. Visit Yad Vashem, Israel's main Holocaust Center.

DAY 12 – Political Realities - Take a political tour to understand the challenges of Jerusalem; explore the Israel Museum and Machne Yehuda market; visit the Menorah near the Knesset. Festive Shabbat dinner at the hotel.

DAY 13 – Dead Sea Area – Masada, a symbol of determination and heroism, Ein Gedi where King David wrote many of the Psalms.

DAY 14 – At Leisure in Jerusalem. Farewell dinner and flight to the USA.

DAY 15– Arrive home in the USA with unforgettable memories!
